TOURNAMENT/EVENT BOOKING REGULATIONS

All groups or organizations (30) players or more wishing to book an event must submit an application form accompanied with a **\$100.00** deposit to the attention of the Humboldt Golf Club. Groups less than (30) players must submit an application form accompanied with a **\$50.00** deposit.

All applicants must understand and comply with the following tournament/event and user regulations:

1. The Humboldt Golf Club must receive notification of the number of players at least (10) days in advance of the confirmed event date.
2. Payment of green fees and/or powercarts for all players must be paid in full no later than the tournament date by the tournament organizer. On scheduled shotgun starts or crossover tees, the Humboldt Golf Club members are charged 50% of regular fees for their participation.
3. Groups with green fee players totaling from (30 – 39) will receive 10% off the green fee total on weekdays (non holidays) only. Groups with green fee players totaling (40 – up) will receive 15% off the green fee total on weekdays (non holidays) only. It is required that all groups taking advantage of any discount will be catered with a meal/banquet by Humboldt Golf Club.
4. Tournaments/events under (30) players may pay green fees and/or powercarts individually on the event date. In this case the organizer must provide an accurate draw to the proshop with a minimum of one hour prior to their starting time.
5. The Humboldt Golf Club is under no obligation to cater to groups that are late. The proshop staff has the authority to fill late or incomplete groups.
6. Local golf course rules and proper etiquette as defined by the Royal Canadian Golf Association and the Humboldt Golf Club, must be adhered to.
7. The Humboldt Golf Club is a licensed facility and therefore, only alcoholic beverages purchased from the beverage cart and/or the lounge will be permitted as prescribed by the Saskatchewan Liquor and Gaming Authority regulations. Beverage coolers are not permitted on the golf course. Those that insist on consuming, or attempting to consume their own alcoholic beverages on the golf course, or its premises, will be removed without the possibility of any refunds for prepaid fees and/or rentals.

8. Each player must have a separate set of clubs.
 9. For the safety of patrons and to benefit the golf course conditions, proper footwear must be worn. Footwear that will cause unnecessary damage to the greens is not permitted (i.e. cowboy boots, sport cleats, etc.). The Humboldt Golf Club will not allow any metal spikes of any type in the clubhouse or on the golf course.
 10. All 18-hole players must proceed to the 10th hole after finishing the 9th hole with a maximum of a five-minute stop at the clubhouse.
 11. The Humboldt Golf Club assumes no responsibility for the loss or damage of personal property or for the safety of golf course users.
 12. All patrons of the Humboldt Golf Club are responsible for any damages that they may cause to the golf course, powercarts, equipment, and the clubhouse.
 13. The Humboldt Golf Club reserves the right to cancel or suspend playing privileges, without refund, to anyone or the entire group, for non-compliance of any of the above rules and regulations, or for any action which is abusive or offensive to the property, facility, or its patrons and employees.
 14. It is the responsibility of the tournament organizer to ensure all participants are aware of these rules and regulations.

GUIDELINES AND CONTRACT - (PART 2)**

Thank you for considering the Humboldt Golf Club for your event. Please read the following guidelines.

Tournament Organizers can arrange for snack services on the crossover or snacks can be provided for each tournament participant prior to or after the event.

All of HGC's Tournament Menus are served buffet style and priced for a minimum of 25 people. We are happy to arrange a buffet for less than 25 people however additional charges may apply.

Meal prices are based on one choice of entrée. If you wish to offer your guests multiple choices, the group will pay the highest priced entrée for all the meals served and an additional cost for the second entrée.

We require an estimated number of participants one week prior to your event and expected number of participants three days before. The expected number is the figure that will be used for billing within a variance of minus or plus 5%. If your attendance exceeds your expected number, our staff will make every effort to duplicate the designed menu for the additional guests. In the event that this cannot be done, a substitute entrée will be provided. The client agrees that no left over food or beverage prepared and/or provided by HGC is to be taken from the premises and such food or beverage shall become the property of HGC. If the final expected number of participants is not given by the specific deadline, HGC will use the last number agreed upon and will proceed accordingly.

All food and beverages must be purchased from the Humboldt Golf Club unless agreed upon by the Food and Beverage Manager and the Food and Beverage Board Member.

When a tournament play stops due to inclement weather, the meal service will still continue. The time the meal will be served may be altered through communication with the Food and Beverage Manager.

Meals must be paid with a separate cheque made payable to the Humboldt Golf Club Food Services the day of the tournament.

As a licensee, HGC are responsible to abide by the regulations enforced by S.L.G.A. Therefore it is the HGC's policy that liquor/home-made wine may not be brought on the HGC's property from outside sources. It is the responsibility of the Event Coordinator to advise all their guests of this regulation. The Humboldt Golf Club reserves the right to refuse any sale or service of alcohol to any guest who may be in violation of policies. All alcohol will be served by an employee of the Humboldt Golf Club.

A deposit of \$100.00 is required to reserve the date and is payable upon signature of the Catering Event Contract. The remaining balance is due on the day of your event. A late fee may be applicable if payment is not received in full.
